
Mango Party

in of Universities." In Punjab, the only such entre will be established at le University of Engineerg and Technology (UET), ore

"It is an honour for our iversity to be selected for he project from among over 30 public sector uniersities in the province and are grateful to the HEC re are grateful to the HEC or providing us this oppor-unity," said Prof Dr Syed Iansoor Sarwar, vice-chan-ellor, UET, Lahore while alking to The News.

"Our faculty has several n-going research collaboations with Chinese univer-ities, several of our faculty embers have earned their hDs from top Chinese uniersities. We are already unning Confucius Set at he university for offering himese language courses, nd the university has been slected as Rotating Chair f China-based UNESCO's ernational Institute nline Education (BOE) for 2021. " Sarwar added

The university will reeive Rs22.815 million for hiring human resource (teachers and administrative staff) for three years to two statt) for unree years to run the centre. In addition, it will receive a one-time grant of Rs6.0 million to purchase study material (books, magazines, etc), audio visual material, including software and requi-site hardware, and office requisites. The university will get approval of the academic, administrative, and financial mechanism of the centre from its statutory bodies and provide suitabl furnished Internet-enabled ccommodation for the centipe.

Applications from universities across the country were evaluated through a competitive process against certain benchmarks. These yardsticks were related to their involvement in CPEC- related to CPEC in collabo-related projects, research ration with Chinese univercollaborations with Chinese universities, joint publications and linkages through university's teachers who have earned their PhDs from Chinese universities.

The China Study Centres being established as mini think tasks to promote academic and research linkages among the Chinese and

Pakistani univer primary function of the cen ters will be to drive collabo rative activities to enhance understanding of Chinese system, culture, and eco-nomic miracle. Universities will be eligible for funding through other initiatives under the PC-1, such as joint research projects, training and talent cultivation, and joint conferences, seminars, and workshops through a competitive se-lection process.

The selected universities expected to achieve the following target on the com-pletion of the project to pro-mote better understanding of the Chinese history, cu ture, and economic development

HEC's move to hold BS entrance test worries students

LAHORE: An abrupt announcement by the Higher Education Commission (HEC) on Sunday to conduct Undergraduate Studies Admission Test (USAT) for admission at undergraduate level in universities across Pakistan has caused concern among students.

The HEC advertisement did not clarify whether the USAT would be mandatory or not which added to the confusion of the students as it came at a time when a number of universities have already opened undergraduate level admissions and announced their own entry test schedule. Similarly, many universities have not planned any sort of entrance test at all for their general BS degree programs.

Besides advertisements, the HEC used its social media channels to make the announcement public which did not receive positive response from students as most of them in their harsh comments termed USAT another 'money-making' move.

"The Higher Education Commission viz Education Testing Council (ETC) will conduct Undergraduate Studies Admission Test (USAT) for admission at the undergraduate level in universities operating all over Pakistan," reads the HEC advertisement. August 30, 2021 was announced as the last date for online registration while September 12, 2021 was set as a tentative date to conduct the entry test.

Talking to The News, a number of officials from different universities also came hard on the HEC saying no consultation was done with the universities in this regard. "No consultation whatsoever. We are already planning such tests for our admissions," said a high official of a public university in Lahore when asked whether the HEC consulted the university for USAT or not. He said that since the advertisement came



from the higher education regulator there was a perception, especially among the students, that this would be mandatory.

Tahir Munir, one of the applicants for GCU BS programme, said the HEC's announcement literally panicked him. "I am already preparing for the GCU's own pre-admission entry but I am confused whether I would sit for USAT too," he said and adding the ETC would separately charge Rs 1,200 for its test.

When contacted ETC chief executive officer Dr Iftikhar said that Undergraduate Studies Admission Test (USAT) was not mandatory. He said the ETC launched its product (entry test) in the market to compete on quality basis and it was up to universities whether they wanted to adopt this test or not.

To a question Dr Iftikhar said owing to paucity of space in advertisement it could not be made clear that the USAT was not mandatory.




