This session is an effort to disseminate the current advances in robotics for manipulation and virtual reality as a non-destructive test-bed, and to stimulate a discussion on the future research directions in these fields. It is expected that the session will succeed in invigorating research interests towards the development and applications of robotics and virtual reality for intelligent systems. Robotics may be exploited to assist human beings in number of ways from farming to avionics, bio-medicine, automotive, rehabilitation etc. However the

non-destructive nature of virtual reality makes it a prime candidate for the testing of robotic techniques or train humans towards the operation of robots in a safe and danger free environment. The goal of the session "Advances in Robotics and Virtual Reality" is to exchange and stimulate research ideas to realize advancements in robotic and virtual reality systems together. Robotics and Virtual Reality are rapidly growing, interdisciplinary research areas lying at the intersection of computer science, mechatronics, control systems, electrical and mechanical engineering. Technologies, algorithms, system architectures, and applications will be presented and discussed during the session.

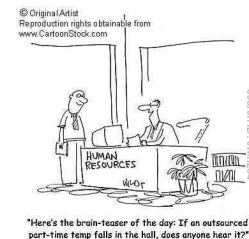
## FACULTY HIRING DURING THE MONTH
