Government needs to reset IT and telecom growth track

The federal government has allocated Rs 793 million for various development and research project under IT and Telecommunication Division for the year 2011-12.

The proposed budget is 10 per cent higher as compared with the allocation of Rs 718 million for the outgoing year 2010-11, which was drastically slashed by 56 per cent to Rs 310 million after revision.
