Prime Minister, Islamic Republic of Pakistan, Syed Yousaf Raza Gillani upgraded the COMSATS Institute of Information Technology (CIIT) to the status of a University on 21 October 2011. Addressing a gathering after inaugurating the new campus of the now COMSATS University for Science and Technology (CUST), Islamabad, the Prime Minister announced Rs.10 million for upgrading of CIIT Library and assured provision of generous funds, necessary for Futuristic Projects.



- Excellent intake of BS(CS) in DDP and MS programs.


He welcomed Dr. Syed Asad Hussain as an HOD and assured his full cooperation in all matters.
