Biography

Prof. Darr is one of the UK's leading industrially facing academics in functional materials/nanomaterials process engineering. He has published over 200 academic publications and three patents. He has been awarded funding over 20 million pounds and has graduated over 45 PhD students. He has been a visiting professor/advisor at IRCBM, Comsats University Islamabad (Lahore Campus) since 2008. In 2017, he co-founded the UPSIGN charity (UK-Pakistan Science and Innovation Global Network; www.upsign.org.uk) that works to support, educate and connect British Pakistani and Pakistani academics.
