COMSATS University is committed to providing maximum comfort and convenience to its students, faculty, and staff. To support this commitment, the University offers an efficient and economical transport service for students at a cost of only **Rs. 46,000/- per semester**.

Currently, the University operates a fleet comprising **14 buses** and **6 coasters**. In addition, the University is in the process of acquiring more vehicles to further enhance the comfort, accessibility, and reliability of the transport facility.

The transport service covers **all major areas of Lahore**. Vehicles operate **twice daily on specific routes**.

Services Provided

- Details of bus timings for specific routes
- Registration of students wishing to avail the transport facility
- Issuance of bus cards to students upon payment of transport fees

RULES FOR USE OF TRANSPORT BY STUDENTS

- a. The vehicles assigned for students' transport facility shall operate on the specific routes only as defined by the authorities from time to time.
- b. Each vehicle assigned for students shall contain a first aid kit and fire extinguisher.
- c. Students shall pay transport charges on a semester basis as notified from time to time. The transport fee/charges paid shall be subject to the following conditions:
 - i. Transport fee/charges once submitted shall not be refunded at any stage, except for special circumstances with approval of the Rector/Campus Director.
 - ii. The student leaving transport facility shall have to return the Bus Pass with the application.
 - iii. Late transport fee/charges as notified shall be allowed with fines within due dates subject to availability of service.
- d. Preference shall be given to female students to use front seats in the University vehicles.
- e. Female students shall not sit side by side with male students on the same seat.
- f. Transport shall pick and drop the students from/on designated stops. Students should not force the driver to make any unauthorized stop.
- g. Students shall cooperate with the transport officials at all levels, especially during inspection of routes/buses/vehicles.
- h. Student(s) shall be fined as per the value of damage or deface to any part of the Vehicle, if caused by him/her.
- i. Smoking shall be strictly prohibited in the University transport and the violator shall be fined Rs. 10,000/-.
- j. Students should be required to maintain a smooth and peaceful environment by avoiding:
 - i. Misbehavior;
 - ii. Political discussion;
 - iii. Religious discussion;
 - iv. Using abusive language;
 - v. Passing inappropriate remarks;
 - vi. Insightful acts leading to offensive behavior;
 - vii. Ragging;
 - viii. Indulging in acts or behaviors that threaten other students, faculty/staff members and passersby in any manner;
 - ix. Indulging in undesirable acts that may disrupt the functioning of the vehicle;
 - x. Keeping firearms or other weapons, even if licensed;
 - xi. Performing any act contrary to the law.
- k. Any acts/utterances that are untoward of gentleman/lady like behavior contrary to social norms or local customs of decency and morality.
- l. Violation of these rules shall lead to strict disciplinary action by the relevant Campus Disciplinary Committee and imposition of penalties/fines/claim of Damages as determined.
- m. Transport facility shall be withdrawn by the University for students/staff found involved in unethical practices/behavior or found disturbing the good order of the facility.
