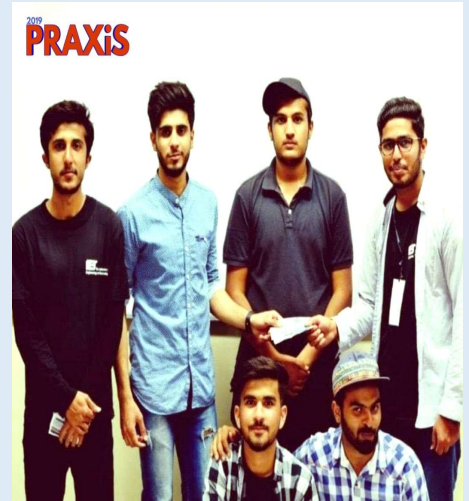
PRAXIS 19
