Limited support for the ban despite the high level of awareness

Enforcement of the ban remains a big challenge-people are not deterred (with few exceptions)

Alternatives are costly and not the real substitute for plastic.

The success of the Ban is diluting from 90% to around 20% (however, much better than many developing countries).
