ISLAMABAD (PR):As part of COMSATS Silver Jubilee celebrations, a graceful ceremony marking the landmark was held at Aiwan-e-Sadr, Islamabad. Dr Arif Alvi, President, and Federal Minister for Science and Technology Fawad Hussain Chaudhry graced the ceremony with their presence, says a press release. Graciously hosted by the Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of Pakistan, the ceremony had an impressive attendance including Islamabad based diplomatic missions from Embassies of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Belarus, Egypt, France, Hungary, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Libya, Morocco, Nepal, Nigeria, Portugal, Palestine, Romania, Sudan, Sri Lanka, Turkey, Turkmenistan and Yemen. A number of government officials, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, as well as officials from COMSATS Secretariat, COMSATS University Islamabad, COMSATS Internet Services, and representatives of international organizations attended the ceremony.

Comsats asked to ensure examination schedule is not disrupted by strike

ISLAMABAD: The Islamabad High Court (IHC) chief justice on Monday issued notices to the Comsats University rector as well as secretary science and technology on a petition against strike call given by the university faculty.

The court directed the secretary of the ministry and Comsats rector "to nominate their respective authorised representatives to appear before this court and explain the measures taken to ensure that the academic and examination schedules are not disrupted by the strike."

Besides, the court also directed them to explain what action has been taken against the representatives of Academic Staff Association for threatening to disrupt the academic and examination schedules."

Academic Staff Association of Comsats last week held a protest walk on the campus and announced that from Monday they would boycott classes against the interim setup and its policies.

Comsats University has been facing administrative issues for the last few years as it is being run under an ad hoc setup consisting of acting rector, registrar and other officials.

The Academic Staff Association counsel appeared along with Assistant Professor Dr Mazhar Ali.

They were asked under what authority of law the strike call was given which has caused disruption of the academic as well as examination schedules. They could not give any legal justification for observing the strike nor could they satisfy the court that the course adopted by them to pressurize the management to accept their demands is backed by law.

The counsel, however, argued that since the university was being run on ad hoc basis, the routine issues of the academic staff were not being redressed.

The court expressed its dismay that the respondent university management had allowed its faculty members to resort illegal activities which inevitably was infringing the fundamental rights of the petitioners and other students.

"It is noted that the respondent university as well as every member of its faculty owe a duty of care towards the enrolled students. It is the duty of the respondent university to initiate disciplinary proceedings against those members

of the faculty who in any manner are involved in the disruption of the academic and examination schedules. The failure on part of the respondent university in ensuring that examinations are held as per the notified schedule is a gross violation of the fundamental rights," the court order noted.

Those who issued strike call were not empowered to disrupt academic and examination schedules and thus cause irreparable loss to the enrolled students. Each member of the academic faculty is expected to observe exemplary conduct so that he or she, as the case may be, is a role model for the enrolled students, Justice Minallah observed.

The court noted that it was the obligation of the University administration to take appropriate measures against any employee who engages in illegal activities or unauthorised trade unionism. A teacher is expected to inspire the students and demonstrate high standards associated with this noble profession. It has been aptly stated that "teaching is a profession that is the mother of all occupations".

Further hearing in this matter has been adjourned till Tuesday (today). — Malik Asad

HEC hires 10 consultants on high salaries against rules

LAHORE: Defying the austerity measures of Prime Minister Imran Khan, the Higher Education Commission (HEC) of Pakistan has hired 10 consultants on higher salaries, reliable sources told Business Recorder on Tuesday.

According to the sources, the Commission is hiring around 10 consultants against BPS 21 and Rs3 to Rs4 lac per month besides other perks and privileges which includes luxury car, TADA and other BPS 21 facilities.

The sources further told that already more than 800

employees besides a number of advisors and nine Director Generals (DGs) are working in the HEC. The purpose of hiring of 10 consultants is nothing than obliging friends. The sources said consultants are being hired for the first time in 15-year history of the commission.

It is pertinent to mention here that the HEC had asked universities for austerity measures after the current PTI government had announced budget cuts in the HEC budget. The decision affected 194 universities across the country and it was widely criticized by the academicians.

According to the sources, the hiring of these consultants is illegal as per Act of HEC according to which no person other than HEC Chairman and Executive Director can be member of the HEC. The act further says that all the employees should be hired as per the rules and regulations of federal government. However, these consultants are being hired on temporary basis.

Chairman HEC Dr Tariq Banuri said that all these consultants were hired after the approval of Commission and these hiring's have been made on temporary basis.
