Comsats faculty seeks appointment of rector

ISLAMABAD: The faculty of Comsats University Islamabad (CUI) on Tuesday requested the convener of a search committee to select the best candidate for the post of rector.

Academic Staff Association President (ASA) Prof Dr Mahnaz Haseeb through a letter stated that the faculty of CUI is waiting for a rector and other principal officers to be appointed.

"It is hoped that the finalization of the process of rector appointment shall be not only transparent but will also be based on merit. ASA-CUI emphasizes that CUI has a budget of more than Rs9 billion, around 35,000 students and more than 2,000 faculty members (whose career is at stake). It is iterated that due to the hard work of faculty and students, CUI is publishing highest number of research articles in a calendar year and is thus ranked amongst the top most universities of Pakistan," read the letter.

It stated that the position of rector should be filled by a person of utmost integrity and whose experience in financial and administrative management is undisputed.

CUI, which was formerly the Comsats Institute of Information Technology, was upgraded to university status through a parliamentary act passed in April 2018.

Dr Haseeb alleged in the letter that under an interim rector, an acting registrar, makeshift directors, acting deans and deans working beyond their tenure and because of adhocism, day to day matters are not being attended to properly.

"While selecting a candidate for the position of rector, focus should be on the candidate's integrity besides international eminence, proven ability and significant contributions to higher education sector. Through this letter, it is once again requested to please avoid the selection of controversial candidates while keeping in view the above emphasis," read the letter. — Staff Reporter
