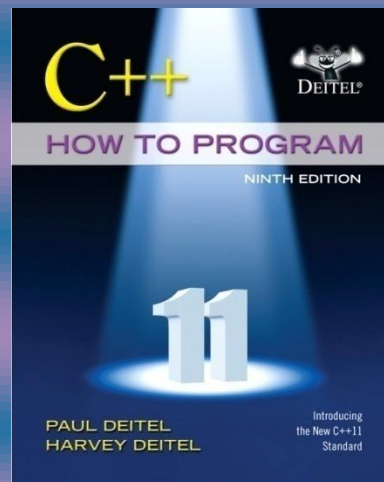
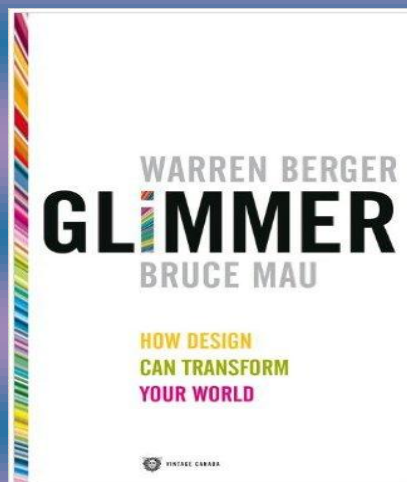
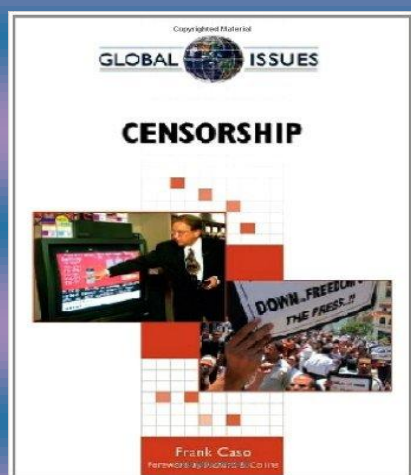
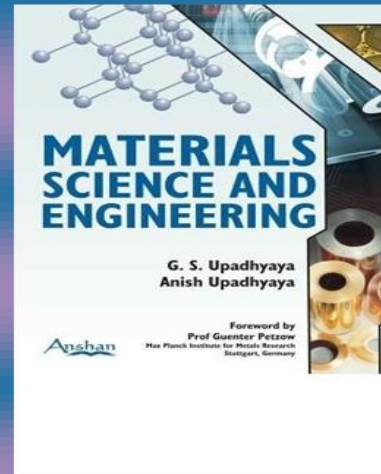
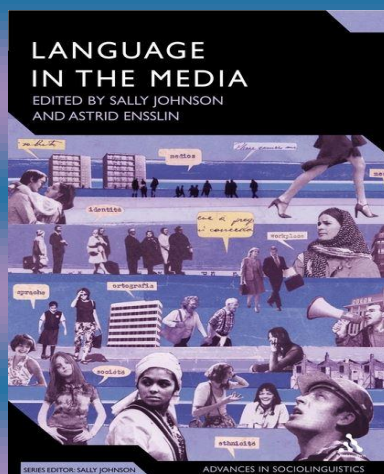
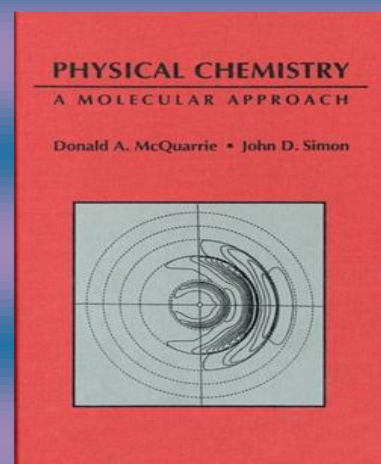
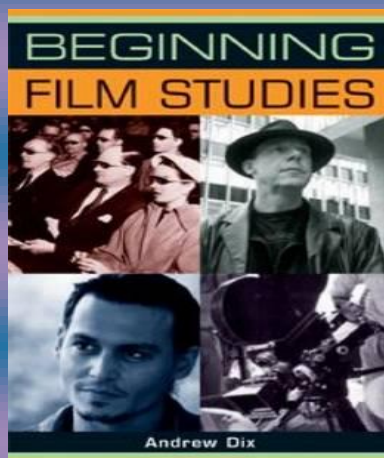
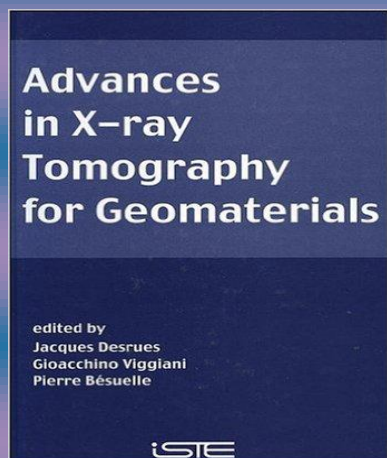


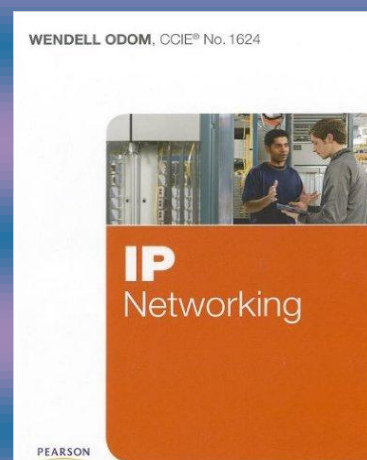
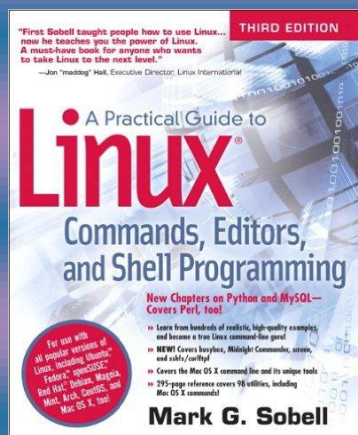
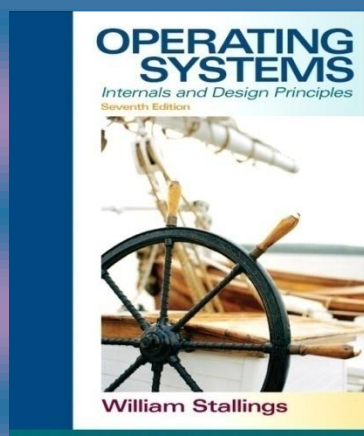
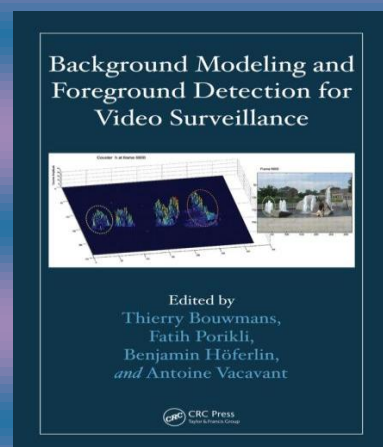
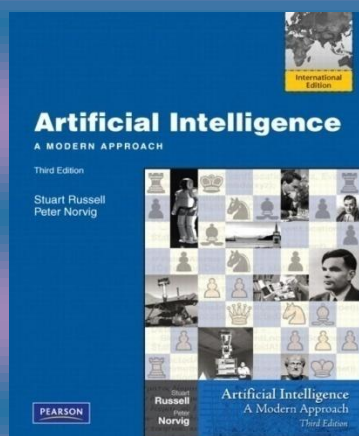
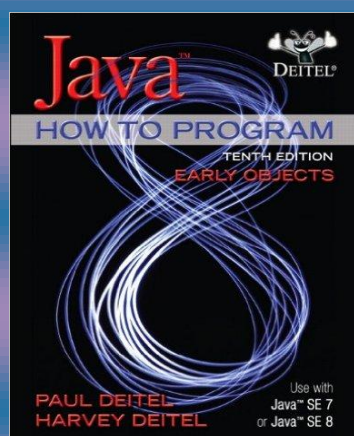
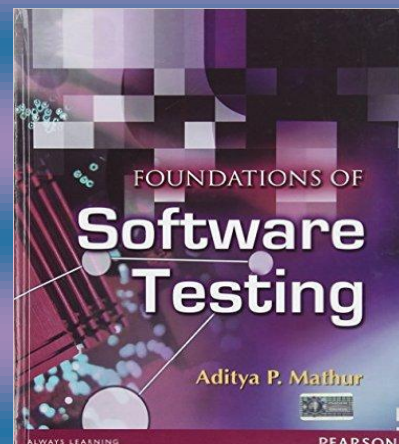
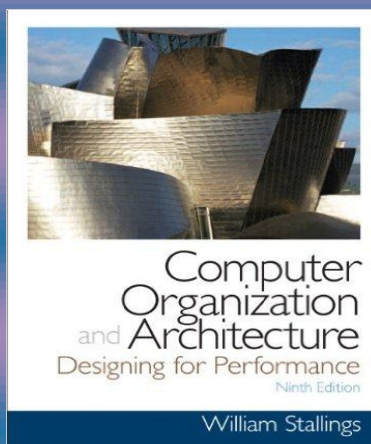
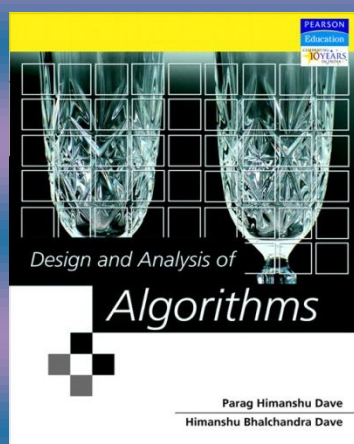
Library Annual Stock Taking

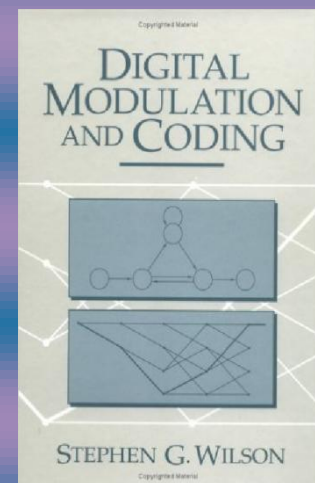
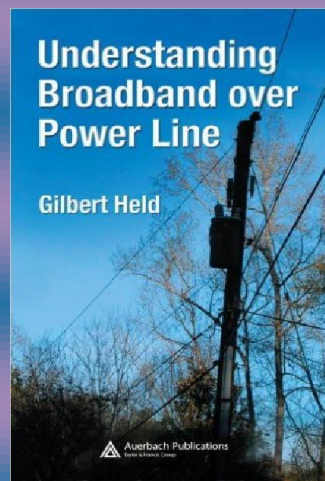
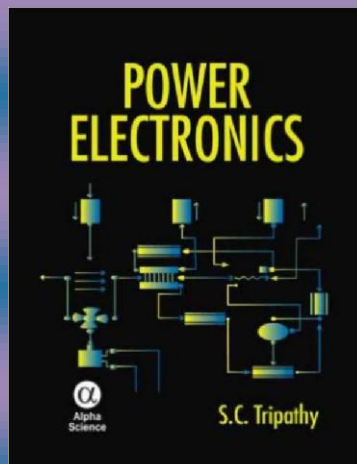
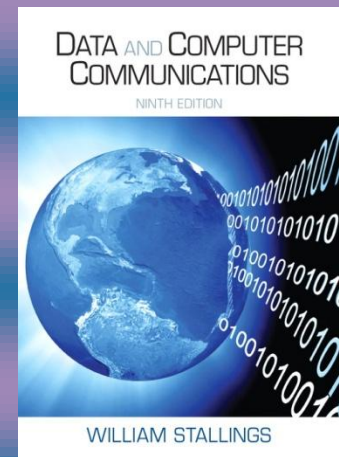
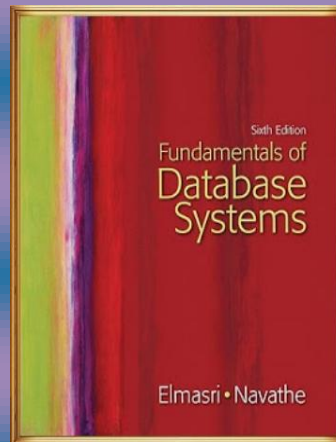
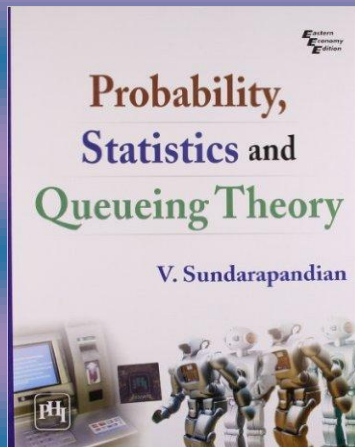
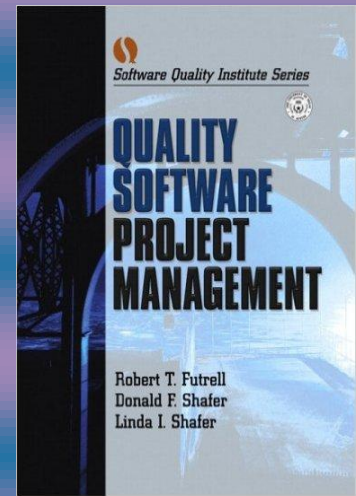
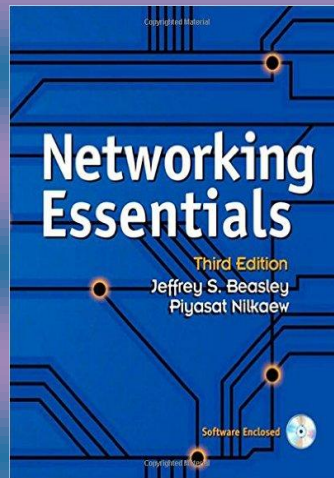
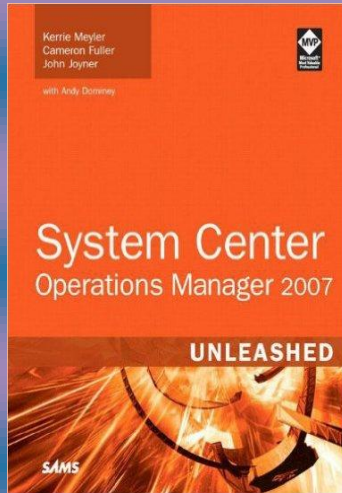
