LAHORE: Local and Foreign experts in Islamic Banking are converging in Lahore on Tuesday (today) to share their knowledge and experience in the Islamic banking industry.

A two-day 3rd Global Forum on Islamic Finance organized by COMSATS Institute of Information Technology Lahore campus is being held on March 10 and March 11, a COMSATS spokesman said.

Deputy Governor Islamic Banking Division State Bank of Pakistan Saeed Ahmad will be the key note speaker of the forum. The institute was organising the Global Forum on Islamic Finance with the theme of "Islamic finance: A viable financial alternative"

The purpose of this two-day forum is to provide an opportunity to scholars from around the globe to share emerging developments in Islamic finance. The experts on Islamic finance will present their papers and share their experiences. Last year, the institute had organised a conference of the same nature with the theme of "developments and the way forward".

The scope of the conference is quite wide and varied area of topics regulatory structures, Shariah-compliant investment, Islamic social thought and corporate governance, Structuring Islamic securitization, socially-responsible investment strategy, Takaful and Shariah-compliant insurance, Islamic project financing, Islamic wealth management would be discussed in the upcoming conference.

Speakers will also share their views on the important areas of Islamic banking such as Sukkuk, Zakat and financial planning, Shariah-compliant risk management, Housing finance and Shariah-compliant mortgage products, Market penetration in non-Islamic contexts, Zakat, poverty alleviation and Islamic banks, Corporate social responsibility of Islamic financial institutions, Management, leadership and governance of Islamic financial services providers, principles of Islamic jurisprudence and legal maxims, Comparative analysis of Islamic and conventional banks. The speakers of the global forum will also discuss the impact of global financial crisis on Islamic banks, business cycles, financial instability and crisis, Islamic economics and risk management in Islamic finance and Islamic finance.



Model United Nations concludes
