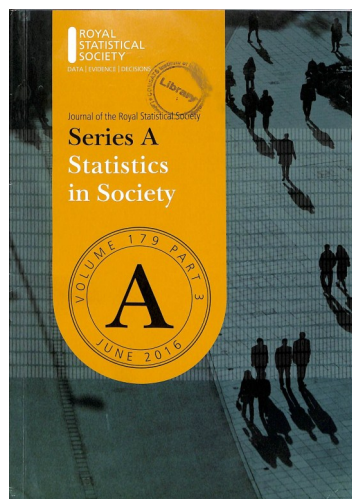


NEAC DELEGATION VISITED CIIT-LAHORE LIBRARY
