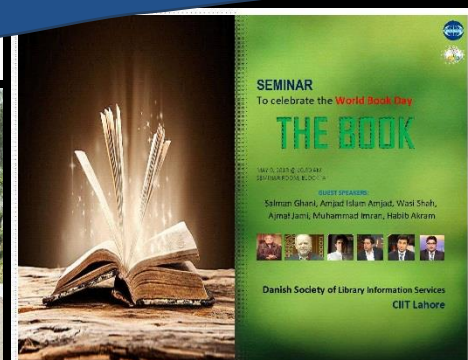

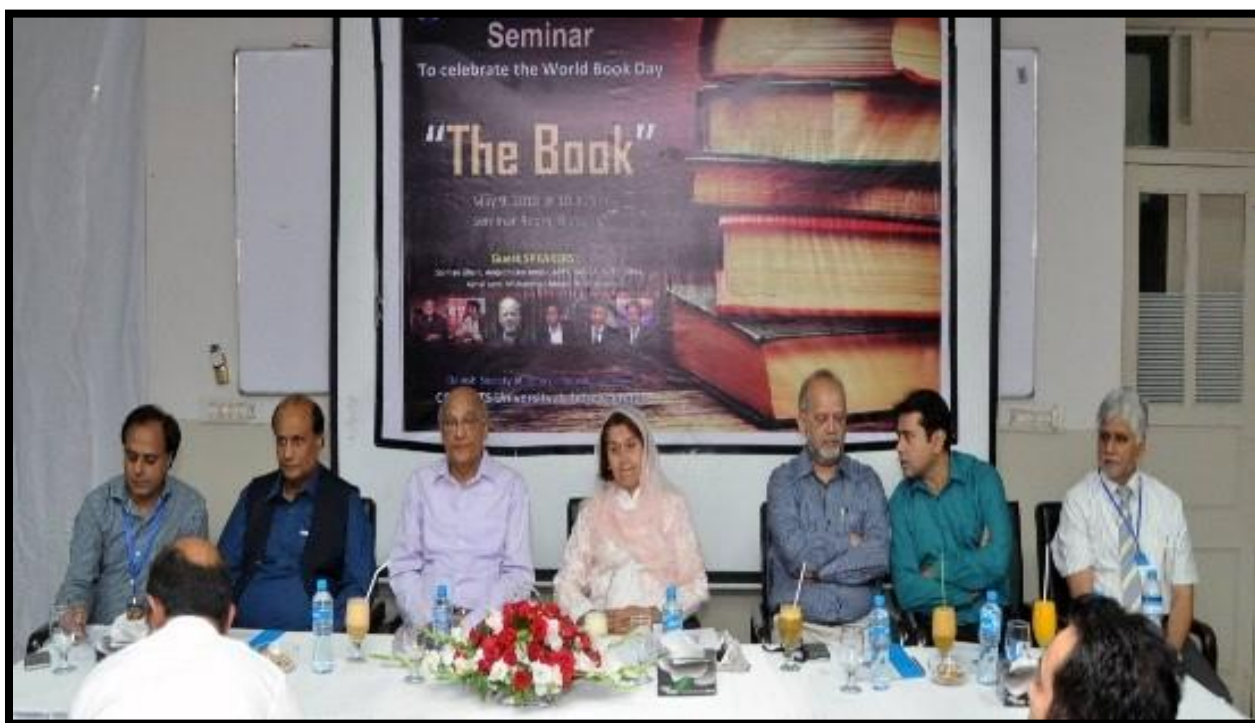

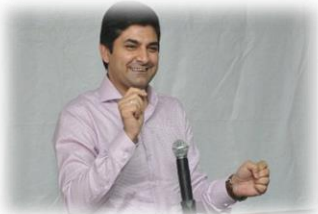
## Celebrate World Book Day LIS COMSATS University

## Prize Distribution Ceremony Student Sports Week 2018

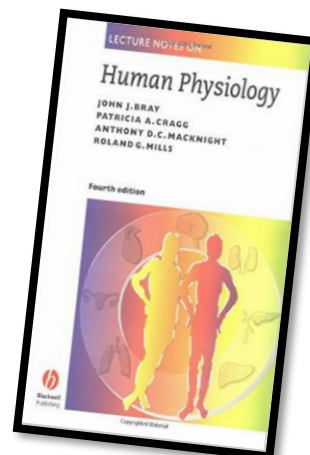
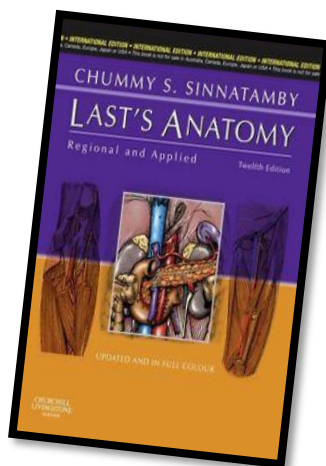
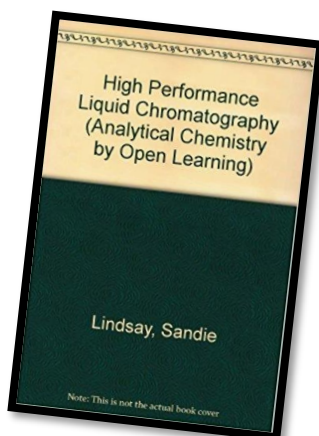
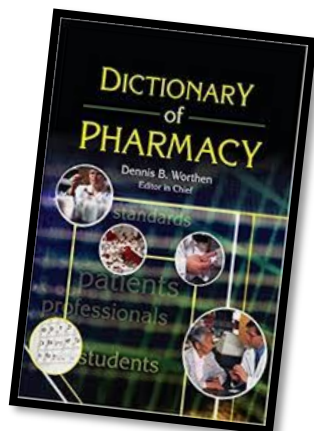
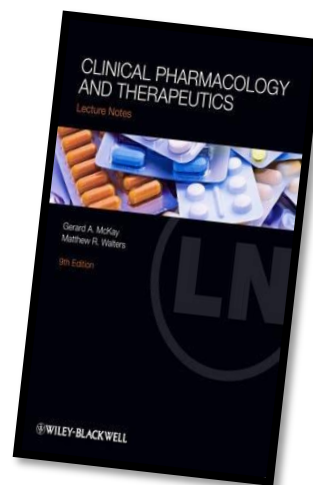
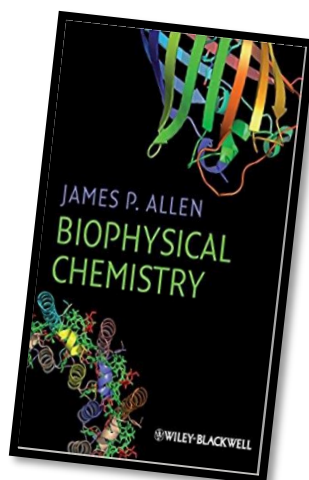
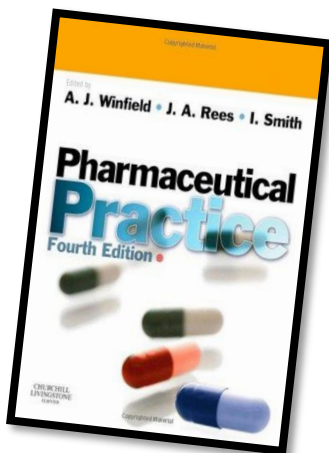
