

Consortium of S&T and R&D Librarian of Pakistan



HEC, Chinese Academy of Sciences to set up research centre

Education Commission (HEC) organised a (HEC) organised a consultative meeting on Friday to discuss the establishment of China-Pakistan Joint Research Centre in Earth Sciences in collaboration with Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS) at a Pakistani university.

at a Pakistani university.

The meeting was presided over by HEC Chairman Dr Mukhtar Ahmed. HEC senior man agenenic meeting of the Ministry of Science and Technology, Quaid-e-Azam University, University of Pachauger and various other Peshawar, and various other universities as well as Dr Yonnggong, Vice Director Science and Technology Division, China and Su lijunt, professor at Institute of Mountain Hazards and Environment, Chinese Academy of Sciences were also present. During a research centre, the participants discussed the objectives, cooperation mechanism, and preliminary roadmap of setting up the centre. Division, China and Su

Speaking on the occasion. Dr Mukhtar Ahmed assured the Chinese delegation from CAS that the government of Pakistan and HEC would extend all-cent cooperation to the out cooperation to the Chinese partner in setting up the centre. He stressed the need for developing a task need for developing a task force for mutual coordination so as to finalise viability of the centre. He said a similar task force needed to be set up from Chinese side. He said that the centres of excellence in the following meetings.

The China-Pakistan Joint Research Centre in research content including risk analysis and reduction of natural hazards ensuring



Pakistan would also be made the a part of this endeavour in order to benefit from their ensure orderly utilisation of experience.

Informing that proposed centre would be an autonomous entity, he said that the two sides would work on the modalities and share formal documents for practical measures. The practical measures.

practical measures. The chairman said that the research centre would be established in Islamabad, which would benefit the CPEC as a whole, the fields of Earth Sciences and Oceanography, the institutes, universities and organisations. In his remarks, Dr Arshad Ali, the HEC executive director, emphasised the need for identifying the domains of work between the two sides. He said that the details of development cost, infrastructural arrangements, laboratory equipment and laboratory equipment and infrastructure, and other components of the centre would be shared through formal documents to be finalised in the following

safety of ecological environmental resources and will promote regional sustainable development to benefit the people along the CPEC. The centre will conduct research on issues pertaining to Earth Sciences pertaining to Earth Sciences in the areas adjoining the Himalaya, the Hindu Kush, and Karakorum. It will provide security support for CPEC by developing mitigation principles and technologies on natural hazards, in addition to improving sustainable development of economy, society, and environment society and environment. The meeting also deliberated on the role of proposed centre in dealing with key scientific issues including environment data collection, mining under complex topography, climate change, water environment, rational utilisation of water resources, tectonic movement and its effects on resources and hazards, mechanisms of earth surface natural hazards and risk control, and fragile ecosystem and recovery. The meeting discussed mechanism for cooperation

conducting research on earth system science and filling the blank of Earth Science research. It also involves conducting research on marine and earth surface disaster reduction theory along with research on ecological environment mineral exploitation, resources exploitation, economic development of mountainous areas, and promotion of regional sustainable development.

The Pakistani entities playing a vital role in setting up the centre are Federal Minister for Planning, Development and Reform; the HEC, Pakistan; National University of Science and Technology (NUST); Quaid-i-Azam University: National Institute Oceanology; COMSTAS Information University; University of Peshawar; Pakistan Meteorological Department; Geological Survey, Karakorum Pakistan; International University; and, University of Karachi. The institutes participating from China in establishment of the Centre include Institute of Mountain Hazards and Environment; Hazards and Elivironia Callinstitute of Tibetan Plateau Research; South China Sea Institute of Oceanology; Institute of Geographic sciences and Natural and Natu. Research; Resources Institute of Geology and Geophysics; Atmospheric Physics: Physics; Xinjiang Institute of Ecology and Geography; Institute of Rock and Soil Mechanics; Qinghai Institute of Salt Lakes; and Northwest Lakes; and Northwest Institute of Eco-environment will encompass and Resources.
