As per tradition CUI Lahore Library staff celebrated the birthday party of Dr Muhammad Tariq. The Celebration was held September 30.2024.

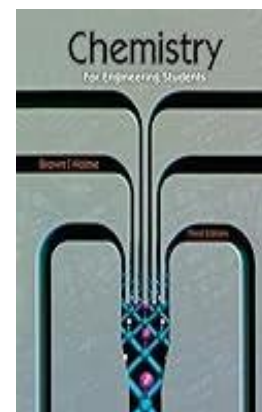
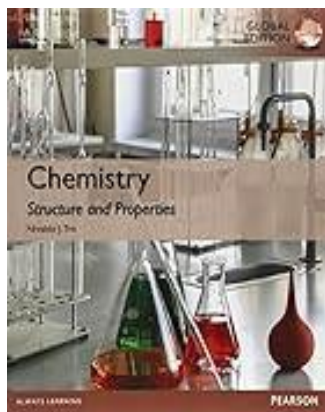
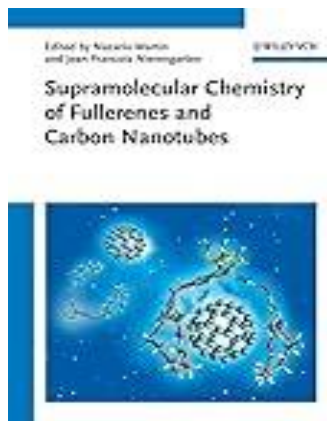
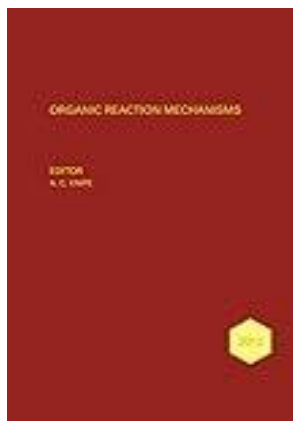
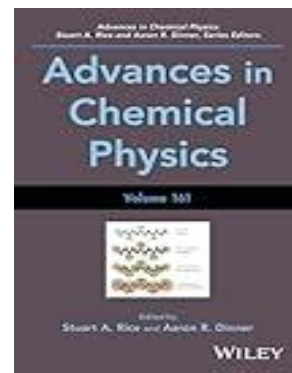
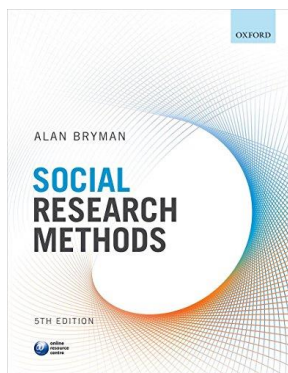
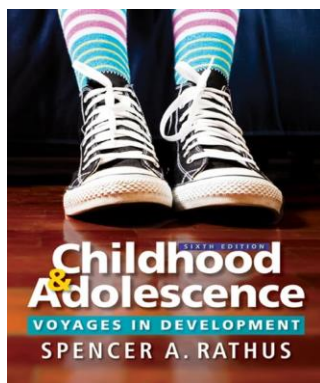
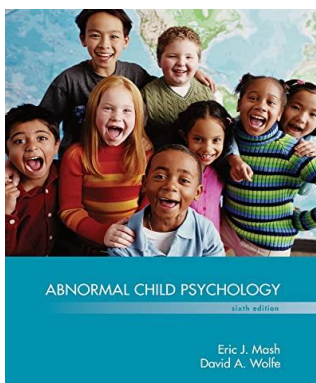
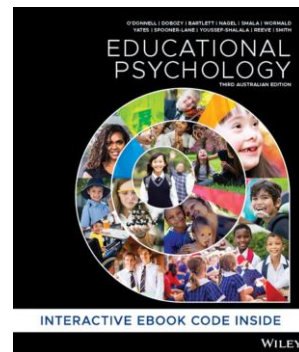
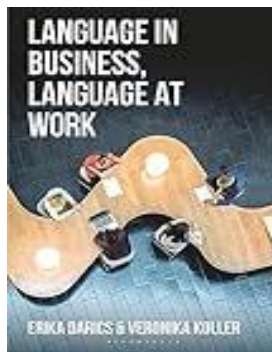
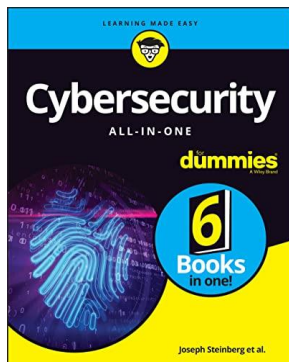

Teachers urge CM, governor to appoint regular VCs to resolve crisis

LAHORE

THE Federation of All Pakistan Universities Academic Staff Association (FAPUASA), led by its President, Dr Anjad Magsi, has expressed profound concern over, what it termed, the ongoing administrative, financial, and academic crises in over 25 universities across the Punjab province, which are currently functioning without regular Vice Chancellors (VCs).

The FAPUASA leadership further observed that the reliance on temporary arrangements has led to severe disruptions in the effective management of these institutions, adversely affecting fac-

ulty, staff, and students.

Dr Anjad Magsi, who is also president of PU-ASA, said the absence of leadership has significantly disrupted the current admission process, undermining the university's ability to attract students and maintain academic standards.

According to him, the situation at Punjab University, the oldest and largest university, is particularly alarming. Without a regular Vice Chancellor for more than two years, the university faces severe administrative and financial challenges. 'Teaching faculty have not received their August salaries,' he said and added that the salary for the month of July was received on August 09.

FAPUASA welcomed the government's recent steps to initiate the appointment of regular Vice Chancellors, and the completion of the first phase of interviews was a positive move.

However, given the deteriorating conditions, the government must act promptly to finalise these appointments to restore effective governance and stability in the universities.

FAPUASA called on Chief Minister Maryam Nawaz Sharif, who also oversees the Higher Education Department, to approve the recommendations of the Search Committee based on merit and urged the Chancellor, Governor Sardar Salim Haider, to expedite the ap-

pointment of regular Vice Chancellors without further delay. The current directive from the Chancellor barring acting Vice Chancellors from making policy decisions or holding statutory meetings, including those of the Senate, Syndicate, Selection Boards, and Academic Councils, highlights the urgent need for stable and competent leadership. FAPUASA reaffirmed its commitment to merit-based appointments, ensuring that qualified and capable individuals are chosen to lead our universities. Any attempt of malpractice during the selection process must be thoroughly investigated, with those responsible held accountable according to the law.

HEC offers over 4,000 foreign scholarships at top universities worldwide

The Higher Education Commission (HEC) of Pakistan has awarded over 4,000 foreign scholarships to Pakistani students, enabling them to study at 25 of the world's leading universities. Federal Education Minister Khalid Maqbool Siddiqi informed the National Assembly (NA).

Responding to a query from MNA Asiya Naz Tanoli, the Education Minister emphasized that all scholarships were awarded on merit through an open competitive process, as stipulated under the Public Sector Development Program (PSDP) approved scholarship programs.

The minister shared a list of universities where Pakistani students have been placed, including top institutions in the United States, Australia, Belgium, Canada, China, France, Germany, Hong Kong, Italy, Malaysia, Sweden, Turkey, and New Zealand. This list, available with Daily Times, reflects the HEC's commitment to fostering international academic linkages.

According to the documents, the HEC facilitated the placement of students in these prestigious universities under various scholarship schemes funded by the PSDP. Among the key initiatives are the Fulbright Scholarship Support Program (HEC-USAID Phase-III), which has benefited 550 MS students and 266

PhD candidates. Additionally, the Law Graduates Scholarship Program for Balochistan has provided opportunities for 100 students to pursue BS, LL.M, and PhD degrees abroad.

Under the Overseas Scholarship Program for MS/MPhil leading to PhD in selected fields (Phase-III), 854 Pakistani students have been granted scholarships to study abroad. Furthermore, the P a k - U S Knowledge Corridor (Phase-I) development project has enabled 1,000 scholars to pursue PhD studies in various countries.

The HEC also offers 100 fellowships for faculty members under the Post-Doctoral Fellowship Program Phase-III. Moreover, 400 candidates are awarded scholarships annually under HEC's Foreign Scholarship Projects titled "Academic and Research Linkages" with different countries under Bilateral Agreements.

These scholarships, as per the HEC, are designed to support academic excel-

lence and build research skills, with a focus on studying at top-ranked universities in technologically advanced countries across all disciplines, considering national needs.

Upon completion of their studies, scholars are expected to return to Pakistan and contribute to the country's academic and research institutions. The HEC has signed Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with several universities to offer subsidized tuition fees, ensuring that talented youth can pursue higher studies in fields such as Engineering and Technology, Medical Sciences, ICT, Agriculture, Veterinary Sciences, and the Physical and Social Sciences.

Additionally, the HEC is offering a six-month International Research Support Initiative Program (IRSIP) for students enrolled in full-time PhD programs in Pakistan. This program aims to enhance the quality of doctoral research by providing opportunities for training and research

at advanced research laboratories abroad.

The HEC has also signed an MoU with the government of Hungary, offering 800 scholarship slots for Pakistani scholars in 2024, with 400 principal nominees and 400 on the waiting list.

Furthermore, the Commonwealth Scholarship Commission (CSC) has mandated the HEC to select and nominate Pakistani students for two different types of scholarships under the Commonwealth Scholarship Commission General Scholarship Program for Masters and PhD. The HEC nominates 10 students annually for the Commonwealth Scholarship for Faculty PhD.

After the closure of the "1000 Cuban Government Medical Scholarships Program" in 2010, the Cuban government resumed offering one undergraduate medical scholarship to Pakistani students in 2016 through the HEC. Other scholarship schemes include the Chulabhorn Graduate Institute (CGI) Scholarships, fully funded for excellent international students pursuing a Master's degree, and the University of Politehnica Bucharest in Romania, which requests four nominations annually from Pakistan.

Additionally, the Moroccan Agency of International Cooperation (AMCI) offers scholarships to Pakistani students for admission to Moroccan public institutions, with 10 students selected annually by the HEC through a competitive process. **AGENCIES**

HEC rejects news regarding exclusion of Urdu as compulsory subject

The Higher Education Commission (HEC) on Thursday clarified that Urdu has never been a compulsory subject in the undergraduate level. However, the subject is taught at levels up-to secondary higher education i.e., intermediate / equivalent, which is still intact.

The clarification was about a misleading news that had been published regarding exclusion of Urdu as a compulsory subject at the undergraduate level.

Moreover, it is clarified that while formulation of the HEC Undergraduate Education Policy V 1.1. (2023), all key stakeholders were consulted and the policy was finalized accordingly. It should also be noted that at undergraduate level, a full-fledged specialized degree programme in the discipline of Urdu is offered for which a curriculum has been developed by HEC and is available at HEC website. The minimum requirement for the general education component is 32 credits in all the undergraduate degree programmes including the Associate Degrees. As far as the optional subjects are concerned, the universities may add more courses as and when required including Urdu for which there is not restriction from HEC.

The primary objective of the policy is to promote student learning, which is envisioned as the ability to comprehend and apply conceptual knowledge, acquire professional skills and competencies, and act as an individual with strong civic and ethical values of tolerance and inclusivity.

The Higher Education Commission (HEC) remains committed to supporting universities in ensuring that the education imparted at the undergraduate level meets international standards while remaining relevant to the needs of the country. **APP**
