### **ISQ (JAIBP) Briefing Session**




#### **Inauguration of Library**

The duty of the AMC is not only to coordinate and prepare required documentation to be submitted with the NBEAC, but it also includes close coordination throughout the evaluation process. An important activity to be performed during the evaluation process is the conduction of a three-day visit of the evaluation committee which is to be organized and facilitated by the AMC's. 
